Dr Hemant Singhal is the Director of the Breast Service, at one of India's most modern cancer centres, located in Delhi.

Dr Singhal has returned from the United Kingdom after over 20 years. He was Clinical Lead for North West London Hospitals Breast Service and Senior Lecturer at Imperial College, London. Dr Singhal is a graduate and postgraduate of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi.

He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh (1989) and Royal College of Surgeons of Canada (1998). He trained in General Surgery and Surgical Oncology at The Royal Marsden Hospital, London, UK and St George's Registrar rotation. He was a Fellow in Surgical Oncology at Strang-Cornell Cancer Center, New York, Cornell University and a Lecturer in Surgical Oncology at The University of Western Ontario. His further training was in Breast and Reconstructive Surgery, in the Cardiff Breast Unit.

He is an accomplished and recognized breast specialist who was instrumental in setting up the sentinel node program and intraoperative analysis of the lymph node in North West London. He is passionate about breast conservation and the early diagnosis of breast cancer.

Dr Singhal has lectured widely, is the author of a number of scientific papers and chapters on the evaluation and treatment of breast disease. He has been part of the International Faculty at AIIMS Breast Workshops and at the Indian Association of Surgical Oncology.
