Dr. Bhat is one of the most eminent laparoscopic and bariatric surgeons in South India. He obtained his MBBS (1972) and his Masters in Surgery in 1976 from Kasturba Medical College, Manipal and Mangalore - India. He trained in England from 1978-83 and obtained the FRCS from England and Edinburgh in 1980.

Dr Bhat initiated laparoscopic surgery in 1992 in South India and is among the leading laparoscopic surgeons in the country. He has been Head of Department of General Surgery at leading hospitals in Bangalore from 1992 was singularly responsible for establishing this department at these hospitals. He has special interest in surgical gastroenterology, especially hepatobiliary pancreatic surgery and laparoscopy surgery. He is well known in scientific and social surgical groups and has held many executive posts in surgical and laparoscopy associations at Local, State, National and International levels. He is the Regional Tutor for the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh. He has been a post graduate teacher and examiner for many years. Many surgeons are trained under him.

Many complex and complicated cases are referred to him from abroad for treatment. He has an excellent reputation for his services, and he has received many honors
