With a background spent working at some of the best Institutions in the country he brings a set of skills, a rich and diverse experience to the cumulative skill set. After he completed his MS (General Surgery) and M Ch (Plastic Surgery) from PGIMER, Chandigarh he did a Fellowship in Hand and Micro vascular surgery N I M S, Hyderabad.

Dr Koul was involved in cleft correction and treatment of other congenital defects and was involved with the Smile Train. He helped initiate and manage the Kerala Instructional Course in Plastic Surgery, a CME course organized every 4 months covering the entire plastic surgery curriculum, a first for the country. A winner of many awards including the Ethicon Travelling Professorship for Microsurgery for the year 2006-07 by the Association of Plastic Surgeons of India he has authored white papers and contributed to books and journals.

Dr Koul is an active member of the Indian Society of Reconstructive Micro Surgery where he holds an executive position. He also is a member of APSI (Association of Plastic Surgeons of India) and ISSH (Indian Society for the Surgery of Hand).
